CV wins the Oregonian Cup Two years in a Row!

- Out of forty 5A schools, CVHS won the Oregonian cup for the 2007-08 school year. This is a culmination of all of CV's academic, athletic & activity accomplishments. It is quite an honor to ever win this award, and exceptional to win it in two consecutive years. CHVS also won the award in 2001. Over 80% of CV's student body participates in athletics and activities.
- CVHS SAT scores have been in the top 3 in the state for similar sized schools for the past 3 years. CVHS SAT scores for seniors were top in the state in 2006/2007.

Crescent Valley High School Needs:

- **Teacher Grants:** The cost of equipping one science lab approaches \$70,000. New equipment is needed to replace breakage and loss. Multimedia and new instructional resources are needed. There are new classes and teachers at CV, and little budget for materials.
- **Facilities:** CV is one of the few 5A schools without a turf field. Baseball and soccer fields need new drainage; they are too wet to play most of the season. The tennis courts and track need maintenance. Upgrades are needed in the shop and greenhouses.
- **Technology:** CV Literature & Social Studies classrooms need digital projectors to share multimedia content. CV Math teachers are asking for digital SMART Boards.
- **CV Boosters:** CV Athletics are among the lowest funded in the state of Oregon. Coaches need to raise more than \$150,000 to cover rising salary, officials, transportation and other costs. Help our teams spend time training, not fundraising. One of CV's activity vans is unreliable, it urgently needs to be replaced.
- **Music:** School instruments regularly need repair, maintenance and replacement. CV Band Uniforms date to the 1980's. The band is doing well in state competitions, let's help them sound and look the part. CV Choir has a new director bringing new music to five choirs, but there is insufficient money for sheet music for the programs envisioned.
- **Principal's Fund:** Some students need assistance in paying fees, for textbooks, sports, and activities. Discretionary funds for the principal allow fee "forgiveness" and also provide funds for excellent opportunities during the school year.
- **Teacher Development:** Investing in our teachers is critical. Professional development is important for teacher retention, improved instruction, and revitalizing content, all leading to improved student learning. CV teachers are eager to improve their skills. Many requests each year can't be supported by the current budget.

CV Excellence Campaign

CVHS Site Council and CVHS Principal Cherie Stroud have identified eight priority areas where the gaps between what is funded and what is needed for excellence are particularly large. We are asking you to GIVE to help support these programs and enable significant gains towards excellence.

A tax-deductible gift to the CV Excellence Campaign through the Corvallis Public Schools Foundation will support these valuable programs and make a difference for CVHS and all of its students.

Establish an Endowment:

Endowments provide an annualized stream of funds for operational expenses beyond school district allocations. With endowments in place, annual budgeting could be done with resources allocated for any of the programs outlined here. Your gift towards 10,000 can help establish an endowment fund for Crescent Valley High School.

- CV Teacher Grants** – Provides semi-annual grants to teachers for current year projects & educational materials that benefit a large number of students. Grants are biased towards durable goods and training, impacting the greatest number of students over time. Administered by CVPO grant process.
- CV Principal's Fund** – Provides discretionary funds for CV administrators to forgive student fees, implement the school improvement plan or other school projects. Administered by CV Principal.
- Teacher Development Fund** – We've got great teachers at CV. Lets train them and retain them by offering more development opportunities. Administered by CV Site Council.
- CV Music Fund** – Provides funds for maintaining and purchasing instruments, music and related supplies for the music program, including sheet music for the choir and band programs, and new band uniforms. Administered by CV Music Department.

- CV Technology Fund** – Provides funds for use at CV for improving technology for education. The goal this year is to buy in-class digital projectors for literature & history classrooms. Administered by CV Technology Team.
- CV Boosters** – Provides funds for use in CV athletics for multisport needs, including purchase of a new activities van, equipment for the trainer, weight room improvements etc. Administered by CV Boosters Board.
- Facilities Fund** – Provides funds for use in improving CV facilities beyond maintenance supported by district funds. Goals this year include field & athletic infrastructure improvements, and shop & greenhouse upgrades. Administered by CV administration.
- District-wide Teacher Grants** – Provides grants to teachers who apply from all schools throughout 509J at all levels for current year projects and educational materials. Administered by Corvallis Public Schools Foundation.
